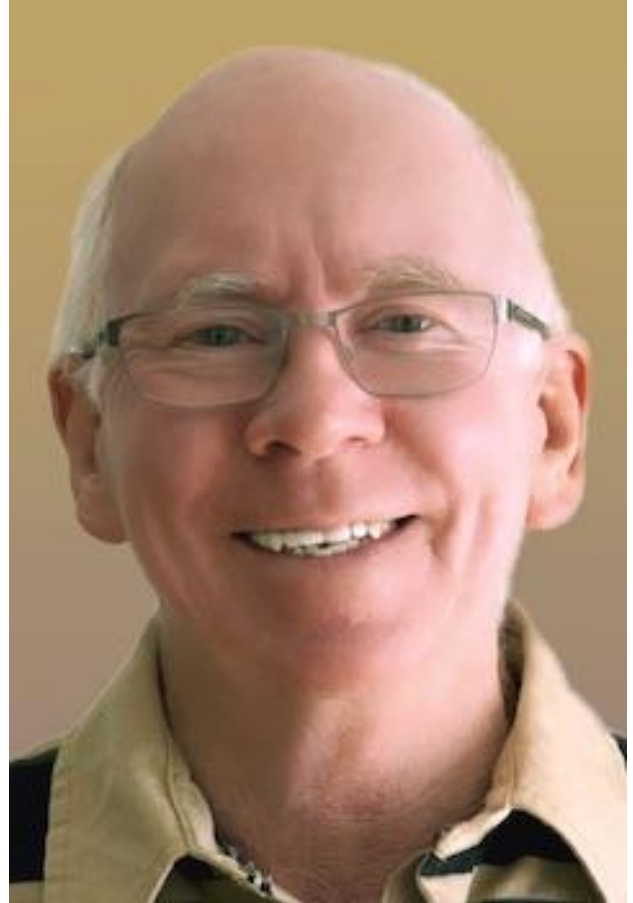
House Director
