

Board Protocol for Winter Storage:

This Board Protocol has been adopted to codify the rules utilized by the AYC Board to govern the assignment of winter storage at the AYC, including the management of the winter storage waiting list.

The AYC Board and Vice Commodore (Yard) will assign winter storage based on the following rules:

- 1) No member with assigned winter storage will lose their storage to a more senior member
- 2) If a member with assigned winter storage fails to utilize the winter storage at the AYC for 2 consecutive winters, they will lose their assigned storage and go on the waiting list, if they wish to resume storing at the AYC
- 3) If a member with assigned winter storage acquires a new boat of equal or lesser size they will maintain their winter storage privileges
- 4) If a member with assigned winter storage acquires a larger boat, they will lose their winter storage position and be placed on the winter storage waiting list
- 5) The winter storage waiting list will be based on member seniority
- 6) The Board will maintain the right to place restrictions on winter storage for new, larger boats being introduced into the AYC fleet by senior members
- 7) The Board may assign temporary, provisional winter storage in special situations.

The Vice Commodore (Yard) will be responsible for maintaining and posting the Winter Storage Waiting List.
