Code of Conduct for Members and Guests

This Code of Conduct has been drafted to ensure a safe, respectful and friendly environment for AYC members and guests. It is written in a relaxed spirit of cooperation, good will, mutual respect and friendly competition.

AYC expects its members and guest to comply with the club By-Laws and House Rules while on the property and its water lot, including the terms of this code. Failure to comply in any way may result in expulsion from the club property and sanctions from the Board of Directors

1. Anyone using AYC facilities shall conduct themselves in a manner not injurious to the reputation, interest, congeniality and good order of the Alexandra Yacht Club.
2. Anyone using AYC facilities must at all times be respectful to the clubs members, guests and directors.
3. A member is responsible for the conduct of their guests at all times when the guest is on club property.
4. Members and guests are to refrain from smoking on the upper patio on the west side of the Club property within proximity of the BBQs and outdoor dining area. Pets are restricted from the same area.
5. Conduct that is injurious or detrimental to the club may include, but shall not be limited to, the following:
 - Use of foul language on the premises.
 - Aggressive, abusive and/or unnecessarily loud communications with fellow members and guests.
 - Acts of violence or attempted acts of violence directed towards club property, members and guests.
 - Harassment of any kind including but not limited to, bullying or sexual harassment of fellow members and/or guests.
 - Inappropriate use of club facilities or the personal property of other members and guests.

Any violation of this Code of Conduct should be reported to a director or flag officer, who will bring the matter to the attention of executive at the earliest opportunity.
