



## **New COVID Lockdown Restrictions**

Dear AYC Members

As you may know, in response to the recent rapid increase in COVID infections, the provincial government has announced that Toronto will be placed in a 28-day 'lockdown' starting at midnight on Monday, November 23, 2020 at 12:01 a.m.

This has a direct impact on AYC and requires the club to set new restrictions.

Please be advised, effective Monday at midnight, the AYC clubhouse is closed and strictly off-limits to all members.

During the lockdown members are requested to not attend the club unless absolutely necessary. Being aboard your boat or remaining on club property overnight is certainly not allowed.

If you must attend the club:

- please conduct your required business as expeditiously as possible, and avoid all unnecessary contact with others who may be at the club,

- members must wear a mask and maintain social distancing at all times while on club property.

During the lockdown, please do not arrange to have outside contractors at the club. Please re-schedule any work you may have planned to be done by an outside contractor until after the lockdown is lifted.

If this is impossible and you must have an outside contractor come to the club during the lockdown, prior permission is required. In all such cases, please contact Vice-Commodore Bjarne Pedersen to make the necessary arrangements.

The lockdown may be extended past the 28 day period announced if the situation does not improve. We will keep you posted as new information becomes available.
